"Learning processes, knowledge and communication among young urban migrants from Eritrea and Ethiopia"

In our research we have met numerous refugees and migrants living in Bavaria but also in Shimelba and Addis Ababa, Khartoum, Cairo, Jerusalem and in Istanbul. Our findings reveal migrants experiences alongside their journey through risky and dangerous environments, where uncertainty, precariousness and humiliation are daily routine. We think that refugees and migrants, who have arrived in Germany, their situation and specific problems, cannot be understood without considering their everyday life conditions and experiences in early stages of their journey.
